CHANGE OF VENUE FOR SECTORAL STAKEHOLDERS ENGAGEMENT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE COMPUTER MISUSE AND CYBERCRIMES (CRITICAL INFORMATION INFRASTRUCTURE AND CYBERCRIMES MANAGEMENT) DRAFT REGULATIONS, 2023

This is to bring to the attention of all stakeholders and the general public that the sectoral stakeholders engagement public hearing on Computer Misuse and Cybercrime (Critical Information Infrastructure and Cybercrimes Management) Draft Regulations, 2023 and Regulatory Impact Statement, will now be held at PrideInn Azure Hotel, Westlands Nairobi and not Sarova Stanley Hotel as earlier communicated.

The objective of the draft regulations:

- a) provide a framework to monitor, detect and respond to cybersecurity threats in the cyberspace belonging to Kenya;
- b) provide for frameworks for establishment and management of Cybersecurity Operations Centres;
- c) provide for protection, preservation and management of Critical Information Infrastructure;
- d) provide for audit and inspection of National Critical Information Infrastructure;
- provide for recovery plans in the event of a disaster, breach or loss of national critical information infrastructure or any part of it;
- f) provide a framework for capacity building on prevention, detection and mitigation of computer and cybercrimes and matters connected thereto as envisaged under section;
- g) promote coordination, collaboration, cooperation and shared responsibility amongst stakeholders in the cybersecurity sector including critical infrastructure protection; and
- h) provide for mechanisms for cybercrime management among others.

The Ministry of Interior and National Administration further invites institutions, organizations and individuals to submit their comments and submit memoranda on the draft regulations through hand delivery, registered courier, post or sent to the Taskforce via email address (regulations@nc4.go.ke) The call for submission will run from 29th August- 22nd September 2023.
